Draft Constitution

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1. Introduction

United Youth Pakistan (UYP) is a youth-led political initiative committed to democratic participation, ethical leadership, transparency, accountability, and responsible civic engagement.

This Draft Constitution sets out UYP's foundational objectives, membership principles, and governance framework, pending formal ratification.

2. Objectives

- Promote meaningful youth participation in democratic processes.
- Encourage civic education, policy literacy, and issue-based politics.
- Support institutional development and transparency in public life.
- Strengthen intra-party democracy and accountable leadership.
- Advocate for inclusive, merit-based public service opportunities.

3. Membership and Governance

Membership, leadership structures, elections, and internal procedures shall operate according to approved organizational rules, this Constitution, and applicable laws of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan.

Every member is bound by the Code of Conduct and the Membership Guidelines published by UYP.

4. Organizational Structure

UYP maintains a federated structure across national, provincial, and district levels, with dedicated wings for policy research, youth engagement, and organizational affairs. Detailed structure is described in the Organizational Framework.

5. Transparency Commitment

UYP shall maintain responsible documentation, public communication, and accountability mechanisms. All governing documents, financial disclosures, and intra-party election records shall be published through the Transparency Centre once approved.



6. Amendment Procedure

This Constitution may be amended through the procedures established by the party's approved constitutional review process. Amendments become effective only after formal ratification and publication.
